

ONLY PERMISSIBLE REASONS FOR NURSING HOME EVICTIONS

1 NO LONGER NEED

The resident's health has improved and the resident no longer needs the services provided by the facility



2 NEEDS NOT MET

The resident's needs cannot be met in this facility



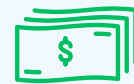
3 OUT OF BUSINESS

The facility went out of business/ceases to exist



4 FAILURE TO PAY

- The resident has failed to pay
- Only applies after resident has received reasonable and appropriate notice of their bill



5 DANGER TO SAFETY

The resident endangers others' safety




6 DANGER TO HEALTH

The resident endangers others' health



NON PERMISSIBLE REASONS

- RESIDENT IS DIFFICULT TO MANAGE
- RESIDENT REQUIRES COSTLY CARE
- RESIDENT DOES NOT FOLLOW THE RULES OF THE FACILITY
- RESIDENT OR RESIDENT'S FAMILY HAS MADE A FORMAL COMPLAINT AGAINST THE NURSING HOME
- RESIDENT HAS REFUSED MEDICAL TREATMENT
