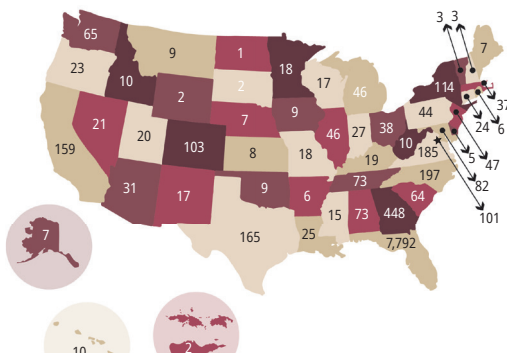

ABOUT TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

IMPORTANT DATES

SEPTEMBER 1

FSU Law begins accepting J.D. and LL.M. applications. Decisions are made on a rolling basis throughout the cycle.

SEPTEMBER 15

Initial deadline for Seminole Scholars J.D. applicants.

OCTOBER 1

Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) applications become available. FSU Law's school code is 001489.

DECEMBER 15

Deadline to apply as an Early Binding Decision J.D. candidate. Please visit our website for specifics regarding applying as an Early Binding Decision candidate.

JANUARY 15

Early Binding Decision J.D. applicants notified of the decision on their application.

JANUARY 31

Early Binding Decision deposits are due.

MARCH 15

J.D. Fall priority application deadline. Priority consideration given to the strongest applications completed by the priority deadline.

APRIL 15

Acceptance deadline for J.D. admits—decision statement and \$200 non-refundable seat deposit due for applicants admitted through March 31. Deadlines for applicants admitted post March 31 are on a rolling basis.

JULY 15

LL.M. application deadline. International students are encouraged to submit their application for the fall semester by June 1 and the spring semester by November 1. The Online Business Law LL.M. Program also accepts applications for the summer semester, with a deadline of April 1.

JULY 31

Fall J.D. application deadline.
