Students in LL.M. programs pay the same tuition and fees as J.D. students. As a state university, our tuition and fees are established by the Florida Legislature and are subject to change at any given time. Foreign nationals in certain eligible categories who have been legal residents of Florida for more than one year may qualify for in-state tuition. Students on F-1 or J-1 visas do not qualify for in-state residency.
